

Syracuse Residents Call for A Resident Employment Ordinance

We, the undersigned, believe that poverty hurts our city and our neighborhoods. Good jobs are the building blocks of vibrant neighborhoods. Therefore, we urge the Syracuse Common Council to pass a Resident Employment Ordinance requiring city contracts for construction, service and public works projects over \$100,000 to employ city residents for at least 20% of the in-state contracted work force hours, and that half of city resident work force hours go to residents of dis-stressed neighborhoods.

Upon passage of a Resident Employment Ordinance, we urge the Mayor to sign this ordinance and ensure that the law is implemented.
