Ira Helfand, MD, is a leader in two Nobel Prize-winning organizations: the International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapon (ICAN), the recipient of the 2017 Nobel Peace Prize; and International Physicians for the Prevention of Nuclear War (IPPNW), recipient of the 1985 Nobel Peace Prize. Dr. Helfand is also co-Founder and Past President of Physicians for Social Responsibility, IPPNW's US affiliate.

In May of 2016, Dr. Helfand led the session on the humanitarian consequences of nuclear war at the United Nations in Geneva that resulted in the successful negotiation of the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in the summer of 2017.
