Priority Legislation for the NYS Black, Puerto Rican, Hispanic and Asian Legislative Caucus

Bill Number	Brief Description
A.2513/S.3695 (O'Donnell/Bailey)	Repeals section 50-a of the civil rights law to allow for the disclosure of police misconduct
A.3566 (Ortiz/Benjamin)	Adds the offense of falsely reporting an incident as a specified offense for a hate crime
A.1601a/S.2574a (Perry/Bailey)	Establishes the Office of Special Investigation for deaths following a police encounter
A.5472/S.1830b (Lentol/Hoylman)	Police STAT Act - Allows the Chief Admin of the Courts to release data to evaluate criminal justice policies
A.1360a/S.3253 (Perry/Parker)	Right to Monitor Act - Affirms the right to record police activity
S.7527 (Richardson/Myrie)	Local Independent Oversight of Police - Repeals limitations on the removal of police officers
A.8226/S.6601 (Fernandez/Bailey)	Medical Attention for Persons Under Arrest - Requires law enforcement to provide needed medical attention to those in custody
A.6144/S.6670a (Mosley/Benjamin)	Establishes the crime of strangulation and creates penalties for the disregard for banned procedures
A.3056b/S.4076 (Fernandez/Biaggi)	Imposes criminal liability for the failure to obtain medical care for a distressed person in custody
A.4615/S.1137A (Bichotte/Benjamin)	Bans Racial/Ethnic Profiling by Police
A.4053/S.2571 (Aubry/Bailey)	Officers shall issue appearance tickets and make no arrests on low level violations
A.8674/S.6686 (Walker/Parker)	Expands the use of body cameras to all New York State Troopers
A.8493a/S.06793a (Reyes/Ramos)	Expands the use of body cameras to all MTA Police Officers
